Bram Timmermans is a professor at NHH Norwegian School of Economics. His research and teaching revolve on the broad topics of innovation and entrepreneurship, more specifically on the role of skills, competences, and human capital resources. These topics are addressed from the macro-level, where he informs local, regional, and national policy makers on economic development, and on the micro level, understanding how both established firms and new ventures can improve their competitive edge. The topic of ecosystems, in all its different forms, has entered his research agenda. Particularly understanding how ecosystems emerge and grow and what are the conditions under which ecosystem organization is particularly valuable, often focusing on the setting with increased digitalization. Before joining NHH, he worked for Agderforskning, a regional research center in Norway, and Aalborg University.
