

Gaétan de Rassenfosse is Professor in Economics of Innovation at the Ecole polytechnique fédérale de Lausanne, Switzerland. Prior to that, he was a research fellow at the University of Melbourne, Australia. The overarching objective of his research is to provide the policy environment that best addresses the needs of the knowledge economy. This objective is met by providing sound empirical evidence on research questions including, but not limited to, intellectual property issues, to the measurement of intangible capital, and to "science of science." His work appeared in international peer-reviewed scientific journals such as the Journal of Industrial Economics, the Journal of Law & Economics, the Strategic Entrepreneurship Journal, Research Policy, the Journal of Economics & Management Strategy, and the European Economic Review.
